Position Title & Unit Senior Radio Opr-Mnt, Troop C Cav, Para 303 Line 02 – 3 Positions

Location: Beatrice, Ne

Military Grade Range: Minimum E3/PFC - Maximum E5/ SGT

Military Requirements: The CPMOS for this position is 25C2O. A physical demands rating of Light. A physical profile of 111221. Normal Color Vision (BASD after 01 October 2013) Qualifying scores. A minimum score of 100 in aptitude area EL and 100 in aptitude area SC in Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) tests administered prior to 2 January 2002. A minimum score of 98 in aptitude area EL and 98 in aptitude area SC on ASVAB tests administered on and after 2 January 2002. A security eligibility of SECRET is required for the initial award and to maintain the MOS. Ability to clearly enunciate English. A U.S. citizen. Credit for successful completion of 1 year basic computer or keyboarding at high school, trade or technical school, college or university. Be eligible for SECRET security access under provisions of AR 380-67. Must meet physical requirements for airborne in AR 40-501. Must be capable of completing a five (5) mile run within 44-45 minutes prior to start of airborne training. Must successfully complete the basic airborne training course and be qualified as a parachutist. Non-MOSQ personnel have one year from date of appointment to become qualified.

Area of Consideration: All eligible members of the Nebraska Army National Guard and individuals who are eligible for Enlistment or transfer into the Nebraska Army National Guard who meet the grade requirements stated in Military Grade Range listed above. In order to be promoted in this position, the Soldier must be on the current EPS list and fully qualified for promotion IAW AR 600-8-19. Soldiers not holding the requisite NCOES for their current grade must agree to complete all NCOES/SSD Requirements within one year of assignment.

General Requirements:

1. Currently assigned E3/PFC- E5/SGT.
2. Not currently "Flagged from Favorable Personnel Actions" or under a "Bar to Reenlistment"
3. Meet other requirements as stated in **Military Requirements** above.

Summary of Duties: Supervises and IOM POR and COTS equipment within the TOC or CP, in vehicular or dismounted applications. Provides access to Network capabilities and performs limited Network Planning, NCS, and Network Management Operations for tactical radio networks. Supervises and performs authorized maintenance on assigned equipment. Directs the installation of radios and antennas. Controls and uses Signal Operating Instructions (SOI). Implements COMSEC, operation security (OPSEC) and physical security policies. Recognizes electronic countermeasures (ECM) and implements electronic counter-countermeasures (ECCM).
