**Position Title & Unit:** Assistant Operations NCO 67<sup>th</sup> MEB, (Para 116 Lin 02)

**Location:** Lincoln, NE

**Military Grade Range:** Minimum SSG/E6 - Maximum SFC/E7

**Military Requirements:** Designated CPMOS(s) for this position is 12B40. Applicants must possess a minimum score of 90 in aptitude area CO, physical profile of 111221, Normal color vision and meet the physical demand requirements of DA Pam 611-21. MOS qualification, if required, must be completed IAW current policy and training guidance. Selected individual may incur additional training requirements for SQI and/or ASI requirements for the duty position (see unit specific requirements below). The qualifications for the award of this MOS can be found in DA Pam 611-21.

**Area of Consideration:** All eligible members of the Nebraska Army National Guard and individuals who are eligible for Enlistment or transfer into the Nebraska Army National Guard who meet the grade requirements stated in Military Grade Range listed above. In order to be promoted in this position, the Soldier must be on the current EPS list and fully qualified for promotion IAW AR 600-8-19. Soldiers not holding the requisite NCOES for their current grade must agree to complete all NCOES/SSD Requirements within one year of assignment.

**General Requirements:**

1. Currently assigned SSG/E6 – SFC/E7.
2. Not currently "Flagged from Favorable Personnel Actions" or under a "Bar to Reenlistment"
3. Meet other requirements as stated in **Military Requirements** above.

**Summary of Duties:** Performs duties in preceding skill levels, supervises lower grade soldiers and provides technical guidance to the Soldiers in the accomplishment of their duties. Assign tasks to subordinate elements and personnel. Account for Soldiers, material, and equipment. Supervise in mine warfare, demolition's and combat construction operations. Calculate logistical requirements for minefields, bunkers, shelters, obstacles and wire entanglements. Enforce safety standards, field sanitation, communication procedures, security, and job specifications. Provides support for construction and tactical movements. Supervises platoon reconnaissance missions and determines the Rapid Field classification of fixed bridges. Direct employment of Wolverine, Armored Vehicle Launched Bridge (AVLB) and the Armored Combat Earthmover (ACE) in support of maneuver forces.

**Other Unit Unique Considerations/Requirements:**

Will be required to attend Battle Staff Course (ASI 2S)
