Position Title & Unit: Inspector-Tester
195th QM DET, Para 101 Line 04

Location: Yutan, NE

Military Grade Range: Minimum SPC (E4) - Maximum SGT (E5)

Military Requirements: Designated MOS for this position is 92R2P. Applicants must possess a minimum score of 90 in aptitude area GM and 90 in aptitude area CO on Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) tests administered prior to 1 July 2004. A minimum score of 88 in aptitude area GM and 87 in aptitude area CO on ASVAB tests administered on and after 1 July 2004. Normal color vision, physical demands rating of heavy, and PULHES of 111121. Selected individual must become MOS qualified within one year of date of appointment. Must be able to pass a Chapter 5 physical prior to assignment and become Airborne Qualified within one year of hire date. Must be able to obtain a SECRET security clearance. **Applicants will review the qualifications for the award of this MOS in Department of the Army Pamphlet 611-21. Failure to review these qualifications may result in the applicant not being eligible for the position.**

Area of Consideration: All eligible members of the Nebraska Army National Guard and individuals who are eligible for Enlistment or transfer into the Nebraska Army National Guard who meet the grade requirements stated in Military Grade Range listed above. In order to be promoted in this position, the Soldier must be on the current STEPlist and fully qualified for promotion IAW AR 600-8-19. Soldiers not holding the requisite NCOES for their current grade must agree to complete all NCOES/SSD Requirements within one year of assignment.

General Requirements:

1. Currently assigned E4/SPC – E5/SGT of the Nebraska Army National Guard
2. Not currently "Flagged from Favorable Personnel Actions" or under a "Bar to Reenlistment"
3. Meet other requirements as stated in **Military Requirements** above.

Summary of Duties:

Performs duties in pacing, airdrop rigger, and airdrop equipment repair shown at the above skill level. Provides technical guidance and supervision to subordinate personnel. Maintains production reports and records. Inspects and classifies airdrop items. Performs initial and final inspection on all parachutes and airdrop textile component. Performs as inspector testers, pack-in-process inspector and as quality assurance personnel. Performs as malfunction officer at the drop zone. Diagnoses malfunctions occurring in airdrop equipment during airborne operations.
