Position Title & Unit: SR GRND MAINT OFF, Joint Force HQ, PARAGRAPH 232 and LINE # 04

Location: Lincoln, NE

Military Grade Range: Minimum CW3 - Maximum CW4

Military Requirements: Designated CPMOS for this position 915E0. Applicant must already have the MOS of 913A, 914A, 915A, 915E, or 919A.

Area of Consideration: All eligible and available members of the Nebraska Army National Guard, in the grade of CW3 – CW4 who are 913A, 914A, 915A, 919A, and 915E-series Warrant Officers.

General Requirements:

1. Currently assigned CW3-CW4 of the Nebraska Army National Guard
2. Not currently "Flagged from Favorable Personnel Actions" or under a "Bar to Reenlistment"
3. Meet other requirements as stated in **Military Requirements** above.

Summary of Duties:

- (a) Serves as the senior ground maintenance technical advisor in brigade and group levels of command.
- (b) Assists brigade and group staff in the planning, coordination, and execution of maintenance support.
- (c) Provides technical expertise in maintenance doctrine on the battlefield for brigade and subordinate element level commanders and staff to efficiently employ maintenance personnel and equipment in support of the commanders' mission.
- (d) Manages materiel readiness reporting for brigade and echelons above brigade organizations.
- (e) Performs materiel readiness management duties at sustainment brigade and sustainment command levels.
- (f) Performs research, development, test, and evaluation duties.
- (g) Assists in coordination and evaluates maintenance performed by contract support.
- (h) Serves as Ordnance technical subject matter expert in training, capability, and materiel development positions.
- (i) Advises commanders on the progression and utilization of subordinate Ordnance warrant officers.

Other Unit Unique Considerations/Requirements:

3-years min/6 years max TIG as a CW3, Complete Warrant Officer Intermediate Level Education Course within 1 year of selection.

If selected for position Soldier will be attached to the 67th MEB.
