Position Title & Unit CBRN SP, 754th CM CO, **Location:** Omaha, NE
(26 vacancies)

Military Grade Range: Minimum E1/ PVT - Maximum E4/ SPC

*****The 754th Chemical Company has been tasked as part of the Army Early Response Force (AERF) for potential mobilization in Fiscal Years (FY) 2019 and 2020. The probability of mobilization is high, but not guaranteed. Pre-mobilization activities will necessitate a high OPTEMPO with an increase in mandatory duty days as well as opportunities for additional training.**

Military Requirements: The PMOS for this position is 74D1O. Physical demands rating-very heavy. A physical profile of 122221. Normal color vision. Must be able to wear CBRN protective gear for extended periods of time. A minimum score in aptitude area- ST 100 and Formal training completion of MOS 74D is mandatory, no other course will be the basis for MOS qualification.

General Requirements:

1. Currently assigned E1/PVT- E4/SPC.
2. Not currently "Flagged from Favorable Personnel Actions" or under a "Bar to Reenlistment"
3. Meet other requirements as stated in **Military Requirements** above.

Additional Requirements:

1. Soldier is required to be DMOSQ within 12 months of assignment
2. Agrees to extend (if applicable) for the duration of AERF (thru FY20) and understands a three year commitment to unit is required
3. Agrees to attend all additional training events throughout Training Year (TY) 2020 (additional UTAs spread throughout each year, Gunnery training event(s), potential NTC/JRTC rotation, Culminating Training Event (CTE), etc)

Summary of Duties: Lead and conduct CBRN Reconnaissance and surveillance; lead and perform decontamination operations; lead and conduct obscuration operations; conduct CBRN sensitive site exploitation; and operate, perform operator maintenance on assigned CBRN defense and individual CBRN protective equipment; plan, conduct and evaluate CBRN training and provide technical advice on all CBRN operations and hazards for the company.
