Location: Chadron, NE

Military Grade Range: SPC/E4 - SGT/E5 **CPMOS:** 92G20

Military Requirements: A physical demands rating of moderately heavy. A physical profile of 222332. Normal color vision. Per AR 600-8-19, promotion to MSG and SGM requires an interim secret eligibility or higher. Qualifying scores. A minimum score of 90 in aptitude area OF in Armed Services Vocational aptitude Battery (ASVAB) tests administered prior to 2 January 2002. A minimum score of 85 in aptitude area OF on ASVAB tests administered on and after 2 January 2002. Non-MOSQ personnel have one year from date of appointment to become qualified.

Area of Consideration: All eligible members of the Nebraska Army National Guard and individuals who are eligible for Enlistment or transfer into the Nebraska Army National Guard who meet the grade requirements stated in Military Grade Range listed above. In order to be promoted in this position, the Soldier must be on the current STEP list and fully qualified for promotion IAW AR 600-8-19. Soldiers not holding the requisite NCOES for their current grade must agree to complete all NCOES/SSD Requirements within one year of assignment.

General Requirements:

1. Currently assigned in the Nebraska Army National Guard with a rank in the range listed in Military Grade Range.
2. Not currently "Flagged from Favorable Personnel Actions" or under a "Bar to Reenlistment"
3. Meet other requirements as stated in **Military Requirements** above.

Summary of Duties: Performs preliminary food preparation procedures. Prepares menu items listed on the production schedule. Bakes, fries, braises, boils, simmers, steams and sautés as prescribed by Army recipes. Prepares serving line, garnishes food items and applies food protection and sanitation measures in a field and garrison environment. Receives and stores subsistence items. Creates Class I requirements using the Army Food Service Management Information System. Ensures proper and complete Class I Operational Rations are assembled for distribution from the Subsistence Platoon to supported Field Feeding Teams. Performs general housekeeping duties. Operates, maintains, and cleans field kitchen equipment. Erects, strikes, and stores field kitchens. Performs preventive maintenance on garrison and field kitchen equipment. Provides technical guidance to subordinate Soldiers in garrison and field kitchen operations. Ensures proper procedure and food temperature guidelines are adhered to during food preparation. Directs safety, security and fire prevention procedures. Performs shift supervision and inspection functions.
