Position Title: Security Forces Member

Location: 155 SFS, Lincoln, NE

Military Grade Range: Minimum AB/E-1 - Maximum SSgt/E-5

Military Requirements: Designated assignment for this position is 3P0X1. The following is mandatory: ASVAB score of 33 in General; Physical PULHES 222121; X-Factor K (able to lift 70lbs). Selectee must possess a valid state driver's license and be eligible for the award of a secret security clearance. Selectee agrees to work rotating shifts, weekends and holidays. Current UMD only supports E5, future promotion eligibility to higher graded positions will be based upon availability of full time unit vacancies, recommendation and selection by the 155th SFS selection panel and available AGR authorization. There is no guarantee of promotion solely based upon a unit vacancy. This position is fenced therefore the selectee cannot take the AGR employment authorization with them to another full-time position. . **Applicants will review the qualifications for the award of this AFSC in the AFECD. Failure to review these qualifications may result in the applicant not being eligible for the position.**

Area of Consideration: All Current Members of the Nebraska Air National Guard and those eligible to become members in the grade of AB/E-1 to SSgt/E-5 with a current or former 3P0X1 AFSC may submit an application for this position.

General Requirements:

1. Knowledge of laws, regulations, and procedures governing security activities.
2. Experience in functions such as controlling entry into and providing control within restricted areas.
3. Experience in response for tactics such as air base ground defense concepts and procedures, terrorist threat response techniques, alarm monitor duties, or security controller duties.

Summary of Duties: Performs duties as a member of the installation security force. Guards resources and areas in which they are located against unauthorized intrusion. Controls restricted area entry, maintain internal controls, and prevent unauthorized entry to operational resources. Implement reporting procedures. Responds to neutralize and investigate security breaches. Perform duty as a member of ground defense force unit. Guard equipment and facilities. Participate in implementing and evaluating information, personnel, industrial security, and resource protections programs. Apprehends offenders; collects evidence; and operates and maintains firearms, vehicles, communication equipment and special purpose security equipment. Prepares and maintains security activity reports, records and forms. Operate tactical vehicles and communications equipment, intrusion detection equipment, associated heavy weapons, and other special purpose ground defense equipment.
