Position Title & Unit: SR INTEL SERGEANT, MCPOD (1ID) , Para 123, Line 02 **Location:** Lincoln, NE

Military Grade Range: SGT/E5-SFC/E7 **CPMOS:** 35F

Military Requirements: Normal color vision. A physical profile of 222221. Qualifying Scores: A minimum score of 105 in aptitude area ST on Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) tests administered prior to 2 January 2002. A minimum score of 102 in aptitude area ST on ASVAB tests administered on and after 2 January 2002 and prior to 1 July 2004. A minimum score of 101 in aptitude area ST on ASVAB tests administered on and after to 1 July 2004. Soldier must meet TOP SECRET Sensitive Compartmented Information (SCI) security eligibility. Additional qualifications for awarding of this MOS can be found in DA Pam 611-21.

Area of Consideration: All eligible members of the Nebraska Army National Guard and individuals who are eligible for Enlistment or transfer into the Nebraska Army National Guard who meet the grade requirements stated in Military Grade Range listed above. In order to be promoted in this position, the Soldier must be on the current STEP list and fully qualified for promotion IAW AR 600-8-19. Soldiers not holding the requisite NCOES for their current grade must agree to complete all NCOES/SSD Requirements within one year of assignment.

General Requirements:

1. Currently assigned in the Nebraska Army National Guard with a rank in the range listed in Military Grade Range.
2. Not currently "Flagged from Favorable Personnel Actions" or under a "Bar to Reenlistment"
3. Meet other requirements as stated in **Military Requirements** above.

Summary of Duties: The intelligence analyst conducts analysis, develops and disseminates all-source intelligence products to support the command. Performs, coordinates, and/or supervises the Intelligence Preparation of the Battlefield (IPB) process; Intelligence, Surveillance, and Reconnaissance (ISR) Synchronization; and support to targeting. Performs duties shown in preceding skill levels per DA PAM 611-21 and provides guidance to subordinate Soldiers. Assembles enemy intelligence information and material. Coordinates flow of intelligence information between intelligence disciplines and supervises the all-source production process. Supervise intelligence operations within combat brigade. Conduct general intelligence training. Supervise collection management in an Analysis Control Element (ACE).

Other Unit Unique Considerations/Requirements: Battle Staff Course (ASI 2S) attendance.
