Position Title & Unit: WATER TRMT NCO, A CO 734th BSB, Para 208, Line 03

Location: Kearney, NE

Military Grade Range: PFC/E3-SGT/E5 **CPMOS:** 92W20

Military Requirements: Normal color vision. A physical profile of 211221. Qualifying Scores: A minimum score of 90 in aptitude area GM on Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) tests administered prior to 2 January 2002. A minimum score of 88 in aptitude area GM on ASVAB tests administered on and after 2 January 2002. Formal training completion of 92W course conducted under the auspices of the USA Ordnance School unless a wavier is granted by the Commandant, US Army Ordnance School. Additional qualifications for awarding of this MOS can be found in DA Pam 611-21.

Area of Consideration: All eligible members of the Nebraska Army National Guard and individuals who are eligible for Enlistment or transfer into the Nebraska Army National Guard who meet the grade requirements stated in Military Grade Range listed above. In order to be promoted in this position, the Soldier must be on the current STEP list and fully qualified for promotion IAW AR 600-8-19. Soldiers not holding the requisite NCOES for their current grade must agree to complete all NCOES/SSD Requirements within one year of assignment.

General Requirements:

1. Currently assigned in the Nebraska Army National Guard with a rank in the range listed in Military Grade Range.
2. Not currently "Flagged from Favorable Personnel Actions" or under a "Bar to Reenlistment"
3. Meet other requirements as stated in **Military Requirements** above.

Summary of Duties: Conducts water reconnaissance. Develop water sources and water points. Supervises and trains soldiers to perform water treatment tasks. Performs operator maintenance and inspects operational condition and maintenance of equipment. Determines treatment method and treats water for purification. Analyses and verifies test results of raw and treated water. Maintains and inventories water treatment equipment and chemical supplies. Prepare water treatment reports.
