Position Title & Unit: PLT SGT 267TH SMC, Para 110, Line 02 **Location:** Lincoln, NE

Military Grade Range: SGT/E5-SFC/E7 **CPMOS:** 91X40

Military Requirements: Applicants must meet the physical demand requirements of DA Pam 611-21. Normal color vision. Formal training completion of 91B, 91C, 91D, 91E, 91F, 91H, 91L or, 91S course conducted under the auspices of the USA Ordnance School unless a wavier is granted by the Commandant, US Army Ordnance School.

Area of Consideration: All eligible members of the Nebraska Army National Guard and individuals who are eligible for Enlistment or transfer into the Nebraska Army National Guard who meet the grade requirements stated in Military Grade Range listed above. In order to be promoted in this position, the Soldier must be on the current STEP list and fully qualified for promotion IAW AR 600-8-19. Soldiers not holding the requisite NCOES for their current grade must agree to complete all NCOES/SSD Requirements within one year of assignment.

General Requirements:

1. Currently assigned in the Nebraska Army National Guard with a rank in the range listed in Military Grade Range.
2. Not currently "Flagged from Favorable Personnel Actions" or under a "Bar to Reenlistment"
3. Meet other requirements as stated in **Military Requirements** above.

Summary of Duties: The maintenance supervisor supervises and performs field maintenance on tracked and wheeled vehicles, construction equipment (which includes that used for earthmoving, grading and compaction; lifting and loading; quarrying and rock crushing; asphalt and concrete mixing and surfacing; water pumping; air compression and pneumatic tools; powered bridging and their associated trailers and material handling equipment (MHE)); special purpose equipment maintenance activities to include: (1) Power Generation Equipment; (2) Air Conditioning/Refrigeration Systems; and (3) Quartermaster and Chemical Equipment; combat vehicles, infantry and artillery fire control systems and equipment, and related test equipment; small arms and other infantry weapons and towed artillery. Perform as support maintenance machine shop supervisor or metalworking supervisor. Supervise recovery operations on track vehicles, wheel vehicles and related activities including electrical wiring harness system repair/maintenance.
