Defense Cyber Operations Element, JFHQ

Location: Lincoln, NE, 2433 NW 24th Street

Military Grade Range: Minimum E5/ SGT - Maximum E7/ SFC

This is an E8/MSG position, however non-DMOSQ E8/MSGs are not eligible to apply.

Military Requirements: The CPMOS for this position is 25D5O. Physical demands rating of Moderate, A physical profile of 212221, Normal color vision, A minimum score of 105 in aptitude area GT and ST on Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) test, A minimum OPAT score of Long Jump (LJ) - 0120 cm, seated Power Throw (PT) - 0350 cm, Strength Deadlift (SD) - 0120 lbs., and Interval Aerobic Run (IR) - 0036 shuttles in Physical Demand Category of "Moderate", take and pass the 25D ISST for enrollment into the MOS producing course. A security clearance of TOP SECRET is required for the initial award of MOS. Must remain eligible to receive security access of TOP SECRET with SCI to maintain MOS, The qualifications for the award of this MOS can be found in DA Pam 611-21.

E5 and E6 applicants must have:

ALC Common Core or SSD II completed with at least 8 years TIS but no more than 15 years

(Waiver: at least 4 years TIS). At least 4 years of experience in IA and IT. This experience will be verified

(Waiver: No Exper) IA Certification: Must hold a current certification under either IAT Level II or IAM Level I IAW DoD 8570.01-M.

E7 applicants must have:

At least 9 years TIS but no more than 20 years. At least 7 years of experience in IA and IT. This

experience will be verified. IA Certification: Must hold a current certification under either IAT Level II or IAM Level I IAW DoD 8570.01-M.

Area of Consideration: All eligible members of the Nebraska Army National Guard and individuals who are eligible for Enlistment or transfer into the Nebraska Army National Guard who meet the grade requirements stated in Military Grade Range listed above. In order to be promoted in this position, the Soldier must be on the current EPS list and fully qualified for promotion IAW AR 600-8-19. Soldiers not holding the requisite NCOES for their current grade must agree to complete all NCOES/SSD Requirements within one year of assignment.

General Requirements:

1. Currently assigned E5/SGT- E7/SFC.
2. Not currently "Flagged from Favorable Personnel Actions" or under a "Bar to Reenlistment"
3. Ability to achieve other requirements as stated in **Military Requirements** above.

Summary of Duties: Creating and maintaining incident tracking information; planning, coordinating, and directing recovery activities; and incidents analysis tasks, including examining all available information and supporting evidence of artifacts related to an incident or event. Conducts assessments of threats and vulnerabilities (through such tasks as authorized penetration testing, compliance audits and risk assessments) to

determine deviations from acceptable configurations and enterprise or local policies; and develops and/or recommends appropriate mitigation countermeasures. Respond to crisis or urgent situations within the network to mitigate immediate and potential cyber threats. Conducts assessments of threats and vulnerabilities (through such tasks as authorized penetration testing, compliance audits and risk assessments) to determine deviations from acceptable configurations and enterprise or local policies; and develops and/or recommends appropriate mitigation countermeasures. Develops and provides training to command and staff on CND matters. Predominantly, serves in IR positions and in AU and MGR positions within limited organizations. Performs CND functions, IAT Level III functions and IAM Level II-III functions as required by skill level, AR 25-2 and DoD 8570.01M. 25D50 will not perform duties as a First Sergeant.
