LINCOLN, Neb. – Approximately 45 Nebraska Army National Guard Soldiers and their families will be wished good luck during a deployment sendoff ceremony scheduled for Saturday, Feb. 14, at the Nebraska City Middle School. The ceremony is scheduled to begin at 1 p.m.

The Soldiers are members of the Nebraska City-based 192nd Law and Order Detachment, which is mobilizing for an approximately year-long mission in support of Operation Enduring Freedom. While deployed to the U.S. Central Command area of responsibility, the Soldiers are expected to conduct internal law and order operations and other support functions at an overseas base.

Among the state and local leaders expected to speak at Saturday's sendoff ceremony are Governor Pete Ricketts, U.S. Senator Ben Sasse and Maj. Gen. Daryl Bohac, Nebraska adjutant general.

The ceremony is open to the public.
