NEBRASKA ARMY NATIONAL GUARD SOLDIERS WILL BE
WELCOMED HOME FROM OVERSEAS MISSION ON SATURDAY
APRIL 15, AT NATIONAL GUARD AVIATION FACILITY IN LINCOLN

LINCOLN, Neb. – Approximately 35 Nebraska Army National Guard Soldiers from a Lincoln-based aviation aeromedical unit will be welcomed back to Nebraska from a roughly 10-month overseas mission to the U.S. Central Command Area of Operations during a 12:30 p.m. ceremony on Saturday, April 15, at the Nebraska Army National Guard Army Aviation Support Facility No. 1 in Lincoln, Neb.

Due to space constraints, the welcome home ceremony is not open to the general public.

The Soldiers are members of the Guard's Company G, 2-104th General Support Aviation Battalion, which was mobilized in June 2016. While deployed, the unit – which flies the UH-60 Blackhawk helicopter – was responsible for conducting aeromedical evacuation support operations.

Media Note: The media is invited to cover the welcome home ceremony on Saturday. The Soldiers are expected to arrive, by bus, at approximately noon on Saturday, so the media is encouraged to arrive prior to that time to allow for processing through security at the National Guard airbase.
