- 8. Have a demonstrated ability to be an instructor.

Duties and Responsibilities: Conducts training in the Basic Leader Course (BLC) in accordance with the Program of Instruction (POI) and Course Management Plan (CMP), Instructor Certification Program (ICP), and the Unit SOP; performs duties of Senior Small Group Leader (SSGL) in their absence; responsible for the training and instruction of a 1:8-10 ratio of SGL/Student for 11 classes per year; performs counseling of students; advises SSGL on all evaluations and areas of improvement; evaluates and conducts tests of student performance in technical subjects and leadership development; counsels and re-trains as necessary; sets the standards of leadership, training, technical competence, and professionalism of Army NCOs; provides mentorship for students; conducts preparation for class cycles; coordinates required support for resources and equipment with SSGL; assists in development of work plans and training schedules with SSGL.
