Military Requirements: Designated MOS for this position is Human Resources Specialist 42A6O. Applicants must have a SECRET security clearance. Applicants must be MOS qualified as 42A; initial award of MOS 42A is limited to personnel in the ranks of SSG/E6 and below. Selected individual must also complete respective Army National Guard Personnel Courses at PEC, AR within 18 months of assignment. Promotion to SGM/E9 is contingent upon the availability of a controlled grade. Applicants will review the qualifications for the award of this MOS in Department of the Army Pamphlet (DA PAM) 611-21. Failure to review these qualifications may result in the applicant not being eligible for the position.

Area of Consideration: All members of the Nebraska Army National Guard meeting the minimum requirements may submit applications for this position. AGRs within 24 months of initial tour or 18 months of assignment or reassignment of closing date of this announcement requires a stabilization waiver. Stabilization waiver request must be submitted with application by closing date.

To qualify for initial entry in the AGR Program applicants must meet the eligibility requirements in AR 135-18 paragraphs 2-1, 2-2, and 2-3. IAW AR 600-8-2, Flagged ARNG and US Army Reserve (USAR) soldier may not apply for AD or ADT.

In order to comply with United States Department of Defense (DoD) requirements and ensure the safety and security of the missions, programs, property and personnel of the Nebraska Military Department and Nebraska National Guard, employees must obtain the appropriate background investigation and maintain the level of security clearance assigned to their respective work.

Failure to obtain and maintain the designated type of security clearance/background check required for the respective work, may result in a job offer being rescinded, separation of employment, and/or other actions as may be deemed in the best interest of the agency.

Prior to appointment individuals must meet the security clearance requirements for the position or submit the required documents to the Nebraska National Guard Personnel Security Manager for processing the appropriate investigation. Required forms for AGR positions – SF 86, PSIP Initiation Form, Birth Certificate (or other proof of citizenship) and Fingerprints. Technician positions also require the OF 306 and Application/Resume.

The use of official mail to forward employment applications is prohibited. Applications submitted using government postage will not be considered.

Applications may be submitted by e-mail, postal mail, or hand-delivered to the HRO no later than 1600 hours on the closing date. Applications received after the closing time will not be considered for the position.
