Position Overview:

As Aircrew, ASEs will: accomplish mission planning as a team of four with ground maintenance and crew; operate and maintain computer and electronic systems in-flight; coordinate pre-flight, in-flight, and post-flight inspections and repairs. Once qualified, ASEs will continue to progress as outlined in the CFETP to Instructor and Evaluator roles and responsibilities.

The 238th CTS supports operations and exercises in multiple COCOMS and bases throughout the US and OCONUS. As a TFI unit, the ASEs will be expected to support the operations and training alongside the 55th Operations Group. Desired qualities are being a self-starter, willing to learn and improve with the systems and changes in technology, and a volunteer spirit to support the operational needs of the 170th Group and 55th Wing.
