AREA OF CONSIDERATION: Open to any current commissioned officer members of the Nebraska Air National Guard or members eligible to join the Nebraska Air National Guard, currently ranked O-3 to O-5. THIS IS A CROSS TRAINING OPPORTUNITY.

QUALIFICATIONS: Applicant must already be commissioned with the rank of captain to Lt Col. Member must be able to obtain the 21A3 AFSC if they are not already qualified. Member must have 4 years retain-ability. Any 21A3 commissioned officer (preferred) or any AFSC commissioned officer willing to attend the 21A1 AFSC awarding Aircraft Maintenance Officer Course (AMOC) within 12 months of assignment. Be current on all applicable Professional Military Education, training and certifications. Possess a current passing physical fitness score within the fitness standards as per DAFI 36-2905. Fully deployable.

DUTIES: Leads, trains, and equips personnel supporting KC-135 aircraft generation, sustainment, and operations. Manages maintenance and modification of aircraft and associated equipment. Administers aircraft maintenance programs and resources. Directs aircraft maintenance production, staff activity, and related materiel programs. Assesses unit capability and advises senior leadership.
