GENERAL INFORMATION: The 155th Air Refueling Wing, Nebraska Air National Guard, Lincoln NE, is accepting application packages from applicants interested in a Security Forces Officer Position. **This is a new commissioning, direct commissioning, or already qualified AFSC 31P Captain (Grade 01 or 03) opportunity.** Grades 04 and higher will not be considered for this announcement. **Interviews are tentatively scheduled for 11 December 2024. (subject to change).** This is a WORLDWIDE announcement for a Traditional “Reserve of the Air Force” position (one weekend per month, 15 days of annual training per year). *All individuals must accomplish the Air Force Officer Qualification Test (AFOQT). If you have not already taken the AFOQT please contact MSgt Joshua Fraser at joshua.fraser.5@us.af.mil to schedule the test as soon as possible (two week lead time for results). To be considered for this position, enlisted and civilian individuals applying for this position **MUST** have the AFOQT scores included in the UPT application package*

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Education: A Bachelor’s Degree is required.

Maximum Age: Must be 39 years old or younger as of 29 November 2024 for NPS applicant. Refer to AFI 36-2005 for PS age requirements.

Citizenship: Must be a US citizen

Security Clearance: Secret (will be obtained post-selection if not already in possession)

Selection Process: Following is a summary of the selection process:

- 1) Application packages will be screened for required contents, and pre-qualifying interviews will be accomplished by the recruiting staff. All complete packages will be forwarded to the 155th Security Forces Squadron for further review.
- 2) The SFS will determine which candidates will be selected to personally interview with them. All travel, lodging, meals and any other expense, is the responsibility of the candidate.
- 3) Based upon the results of the personal interviews and packages, the SFS may select a candidate(s) to continue in the selection process. Those not selected to continue will be eliminated from further consideration for this announcement only. However, they are NOT necessarily considered ineligible to apply for future vacancies.
- 4) Candidates selected to continue will be referred to the recruiting office for qualification screening.
- 5) Candidates will complete all required processing actions to secure approval as a candidate for commissioning and technical training. The recruiting process can take up to 12 months to accomplish all required tasks.
- 6) Your package must be approved by the 155ARW Wing Commander before your finalized package is forwarded to the National Guard Bureau (NGB) for approval.
- 7) TFOT is held at Maxwell AFB and lasts six weeks. Upon graduation from TFOT, candidates are commissioned as 2nd Lieutenants in the USAF Reserve.
