**Position Title:** Chief of Training (13026)

**Location:** JFHQ-NE, Lincoln, NE

**Military Grade Range:** Minimum SFC/E7(P) – MSG/E8

**Military Requirements:** Designated MOS for this position is 00F50. Must meet the physical standards in FM 7-22 and weight standards in AR 600-9; must currently hold SQI "8" certified instructor; possess a favorable security investigation, possess a SECRET clearance or higher or be able to obtain a SECRET clearance; have no speech impediments; must meet suitability requirements. Position is specific to BLC course operations and requires experience with the BLC POI/CMP and the NCOA.

**Area of Consideration:** All members of the Nebraska Army National Guard and meeting the minimum requirements may submit applications for this position. **All current hiring procedures will be in accordance with NEARNG Selection Process Policy guidelines. AGR's within 24 months of initial tour or 18 months of assignment or reassignment of closing date of this announcement requires a stabilization waiver. Stabilization waiver request must be submitted with application by closing date.**

**Qualified applicants will be referred to the selecting official in the following order.**

**Area 1:** Lateral Transfers of on-board AGR personnel (MSG/E8) who meet the Military Requirements for the position and have 80 hours of instruction time. Soldiers on interim promotions will not be considered as Area 1 applicants.

**Area 2:** Select Train Educate Promote List (STEP) of on-board AGRs CPMOS qualified (SFC/E7, 00F) who meet the Military Requirements for the position.

**General Requirements:**

1. The ability to develop procedural guidance.
2. The ability to communicate both orally and in writing.
3. Have a demonstrated ability to be a facilitator.
4. The ability to apply time management techniques.

**Summary of Duties:** Responsible for the conduct of the Basic Leader Course as set in the Course Management Plan and Program of Instruction as set by TRADOC and NCOL CoE; ensures Instructor Certification Program for SSGL/SGL Cadre; assists with development and refinement of NCOA SOP; ensures assigned cadre comply with TRADOC accreditation standards; evaluates and mentors Senior Small Group Leaders (SSGL) and Small Group Leaders (SGL); ensures all SSGL and SGL certification files are current and maintained; establishes and executes new instructor training program and sustainment program for seasoned instructors; ensure required training resources and reference materials are available for training; ensures instructors receive support materials and equipment required for training; ensures compliance with safety and environmental protection rules, regulations, laws and course requirements; ensures facilities, materials, equipment and systems are properly maintained; implement NCOL CoE BLC updates and changes to courseware; responsible for FTUS staff of 6- SSGLs and 24- SGLs, with additional ADOS cadre as needed to facilitate annual student capacity in excess of 1800.

**Areas of Special Emphasis:** Accreditation; evaluates course effectiveness and efficiency; Instructor Evaluation Program, OPSEC, BLC MTT requirements; TRADOC classroom automation upgrades; Staff and Student safety.

*To qualify for initial entry in the AGR Program applicants must meet the eligibility requirements in AR 135-18 paragraphs 2-1, 2-2, and 2-3. IAW AR 600-8-2, Flagged ARNG and US Army Reserve (USAR) soldier may not apply for AD or ADT.*

*In order to comply with United States Department of Defense (DoD) requirements and ensure the safety and security of the missions, programs, property and personnel of the Nebraska Military Department and Nebraska National Guard, employees must obtain the appropriate background investigation and maintain the level of security clearance assigned to their respective work.*

*Failure to obtain and maintain the designated type of security clearance/background check required for the respective work, may result in a job offer being rescinded, separation of employment, and/or other actions as may be deemed in the best interest of the agency.*

*Prior to appointment individuals must meet the security clearance requirements for the position or submit the required documents to the Nebraska National Guard Personnel Security Manager for processing the appropriate investigation. Required forms for AGR positions – SF 86, PSIP Initiation Form, Birth Certificate (or other proof of citizenship) and Fingerprints. Technician positions also require the OF 306 and Application/Resume.*
