**J34 Logistics NCOIC**

The Nebraska National Guard (NENG) – Joint Force Headquarters/J3 is accepting applications for a Technical Sergeant or Master Sergeant to complement the joint staff. The J34 Logistics NCOIC is a critical leadership and staff role responsible for operational logistics, sustainment, and mobility. This position ensures Nebraska National Guard forces are prepared to execute their state and federal missions across domestic and international operational spectrums. This announcement is for a Drill Status Guardsman (DSG) position. This position is available to current members of the Nebraska Air National Guard. **Grade Requirement:** TSgt (E-6) or MSgt (E-7)

**AFSC:** Any AFSC

**Primary Duties:**

**Operational Logistics Advisor:** Serves as the principal enlisted advisor to the J34 OIC and J3 Director on all matters pertaining to operational logistics, sustainment, and mobility. Ensures that all Joint Operations, published OPLANS, and CONPLANS are logistically feasible and adequately resourced.

**Deployment and Movement Control:** Directs and tracks the tactical and operational movement of personnel, equipment, and supplies. Coordinates airlift, line haul, and organic transportation assets to support Defense Support of Civil Authorities (DSCA) missions, National Guard Civil Support (NGCS) events, and joint exercises.

**JOC Logistics Integration:** Serves as the senior operations logistics liaison within the Joint Operations Center (JOC) during steady-state and crisis operations. Maintains the logistics Common Operating Picture (COP), tracking critical supply classes, equipment readiness rates, and movement timelines.

**JRSOI Management:** Leads planning and execution for Joint Reception, Staging, Onward Movement, and Integration (JRSOI) operations during state emergencies. Ensures incoming joint forces and interagency partners are properly received, equipped, and staged for immediate operational deployment.

**Interagency Logistics Synchronization:** Coordinates with state and federal emergency management agencies (e.g., NEMA, FEMA) and civilian contractors to source, track, and distribute critical resources during disaster response operations. Translates civilian resource requests into military logistical requirements.

**Cross-Directorate Coordination:** Acts as the primary J3 conduit to the J4 (Logistics) and J8 (Finance/Resource Management) directorates. Synchronizes operational requirements with sustainment capabilities and ensures proper funding codes and logistical pipelines are established for mission execution.

**Eligibility Requirements:**

- **Retention:** Must have or be able to attain 24+ months of retainability.
- **Skills:** Must have demonstrated strong leadership and managerial skills. Exceptional written and oral communication skills; proven ability to synthesize complex operational data into concise, actionable staff update briefs for flag officers and senior executives.

- Physical Requirements: Must be in good physical condition and be medically qualified in accordance with applicable Air Force and Air National Guard regulations. Must meet Air Force and Air National Guard weight and fitness standards.
- Security Requirements: Must be able to meet applicable security requirements to hold appropriate security clearance (Secret). TS/SCI clearance desirable.
- Desired Experience:
  - Operational Logistics: Extensive background in planning, forecasting, and executing logistical support (supply, maintenance, transportation) for dynamic military operations.
  - Mobility & Movement Control: Proven expertise in load planning, unit movement operations, and coordinating multi-modal transportation (air, ground) for rapid deployment.
  - JRSOI Expertise: Practical experience designing and running Joint Reception, Staging, Onward Movement, and Integration nodes during state or federal mobilizations.
  - Logistics Command & Control (C2): Proficiency in utilizing military and civilian logistics tracking systems to maintain a real-time log-COP for command situational awareness.
  - DSCA Resource Management: Deep understanding of how to process, validate, and fulfill logistical requirements during domestic emergencies in coordination with civil authorities.
  - Joint Staff Synchronization: Strong ability to integrate across staff sections, specifically bridging the gap between J3 (Current Operations) and J4 (Sustainment/Supply Chain).
