CHIEF MASTER SERGEANT JEFFREY A. HORNE

Chief Master Sergeant Jeffrey A. Horne is the Nebraska State Command Chief, Nebraska Air National Guard. As State Command Chief, he serves as the advisor to the Adjutant General and staff on matters of health, welfare, morale, professional development and effective utilization of more than 800 Air National Guard enlisted personnel assigned to the State.

Chief Horne enlisted in the Nebraska Air National Guard in March of 1985 and attended Technical School at Chanute AFB, Illinois as a Fire Protection Specialist. In March of 1987, he returned to Chanute AFB, Illinois to attend the very challenging and specialized Rescue School. He has participated in Operations DESERT SHIELD, DESERT STORM, ENDURING FREEDOM and IRAQI FREEDOM. During these operations, Chief Horne planned and executed firefighting and humanitarian operations in support of interests in Iraq and Diego Garcia. Additionally, he has participated in various Defense Support of Civilian Authorities humanitarian and rescue missions. In 2000, Chief Horne was selected as the full-time Technician Fire Chief.

Prior to his current position, Chief Horne was the 155th Air Refueling Wing Command Chief.
