COLONEL CHRISTOPHER L. HESSE

Col. Christopher L. Hesse serves as the Chief of Staff - Joint Staff, Joint Force Headquarters, Lincoln, Nebraska. JFHQ's mission is to provide mission ready units available to deploy globally and to provide capabilities to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Nebraska and the homeland.

Col. Hesse joined the Nebraska Air National Guard in 1996 after graduating from the University of Kansas with a degree in Aerospace Engineering. He was commissioned in November of 1997 via the Academy of Military Science (AMS). Following AMS he attended Specialized Undergraduate Pilot Training (SUPT) at Columbus Air Force Base. Mississippi, where he graduated in 1999. Following SUPT he attended the KC-135R Initial Qualification Course at Altus Air Force Base, Oklahoma, and graduated in the fall of 1999. Col. Hesse then returned to Lincoln to serve as a traditional guardsman flying the KC-135R. Col. Hesse became a full-time technician in the fall of 2000 and he served as current operations officer, deputy chief of standards and evaluations, chief of training, and assistant flight commander. In the summer of 2008, he attended the KC-135R Weapons Instructor Course located at Fairchild Air Force Base, Washington, graduating in December of 2008. Upon his return to Lincoln, Col. Hesse served as the chief of tactics, assistant



director of operations, director of operations and commander of the 173rd Air Refueling Squadron. In the spring of 2016, he assumed command of the 155th Maintenance Group and in 2021 moved to Joint Force Headquarters to serve as the Director of Staff - Air. He has participated in many combat and contingency operations including, Northern Watch, Joint Forge, Enduring Freedom, Noble Eagle, and Iraqi Freedom.
