

Chief Master Sergeant Scott M. Tontegode

CMSgt Scott M. Tontegode serves as the State Command Chief for the Nebraska Air National Guard. He is the principal advisor to the Adjutant General and senior staff on all matters concerning the health, welfare, morale, professional development, and effective utilization of the more than 900 Air National Guard enlisted Airmen assigned to the state.

Chief Tontegode enlisted in the Nebraska Air National Guard in May of 1987 and graduated from the Refrigeration Specialist Course at Sheppard Air Force Base in January of 1988. Chief Tontegode has served his entire career with the Nebraska Air National Guard, holding positions within the 155th Air Refueling Wing's Civil Engineer Squadron, Medical Group and in the Wing Headquarters. During his tenure as the Wing's Occupational Safety Manager, he played a key role in developing multiple Air Force and Air National Guard safety courses. He also provided training to both military and civilian members across several states on safety and health regulations, safety program management, and foundational safety concepts. Chief Tontegode has deployed to Mississippi in support of Joint Task Force Katrina and to Antarctica as an Occupational Safety Specialist in support of Operation Deep Freeze. Additionally, he has been involved in numerous state activations in response to natural disasters. Prior to his current assignment, Chief Tontegode served as the 155th Air Refueling Wing Command Chief.
