

Warrior Leader Course Frequently Asked Questions

1.) What clothing and equipment do I need to bring to Camp Ashland for school?

A.) Packing list can be found on class specific pages

2.) If I report without a Pre-Execution checklist, what will happen?

A.) Your Commander will have seventy-two hours to provide the Commandant with the checklist or you will be released from the course.

3.) What time must I report to Camp Ashland for NCOES?

A.) In-processing runs from 0800-1800 on the ATRRS report date. Soldiers arriving after the report date will be denied enrollment. Soldiers arriving prior to the report date will need to contact the staff duty at 402.309.7608 for instructions.

4.) Can my family attend graduation? Is there lodging available for them?

A.) Yes. Families are encouraged to attend graduation. There are several hotels within minutes of Camp Ashland.

5.) Are there ATMs available?

A.) Yes. There is an ATM located on Camp Ashland in Bldg 508.

6.) Can I receive E-mail/Access the Internet while I am at Camp Ashland?

A.) Yes. Several WiFi Hotspots are available as well as controlled internet access within the classrooms. Web based e-mail access is NOT allowed in the classrooms.

7.) Is there a Clothing and Sales store located on Camp Ashland?

A.) No. There is a small PX facility. However, clothing sales and alterations are not available. Students must ensure they bring all required uniforms and that they are IAW AR 670-1.

8.) Am I required to bring a protective mask to WLC?

A.) Yes, a protective mask is required. The Regiment will NOT supply students with protective masks. Failure to report for WLC without a protective mask may result in the students being released from the course.

8.) Am I required to bring a Lensatic compass and protractor (GTA 5-2-12) to WLC?

A.) Yes. The Regiment will NOT issue Lensatic compasses or protractors to students attending courses at Camp Ashland.

9.) Am I required to bring all the TA-50 items listed on my course packing list?

A.) Yes. The Regiment will NOT issue TA-50 items to students attending courses at Camp Ashland. However, during summer months, students are not required to bring extreme cold weather items.
