

Warrior Leader Course Frequently Asked Questions

1.) What clothing and equipment do I need to bring to Camp Ashland for WLC?

A.) Packing list can be found attached to Welcome Letter.

2.) What documents do I need to report in to WLC?

A.) You will need 3 copies of your orders, 3 copies of any profiling or MEB documentation, 3 copies of any Wounded Warrior Memo enrollment, your itinerary, and any other documentation you may have to expedite your enrollment.

3.) What time must I report to Camp Ashland for NCOES?

A.) In-processing runs from 0800-1800 on the ATRRS report date. Soldiers arriving after the report time will be counseled on a DA 4856. Soldiers arriving after the report date will be denied enrollment. Soldiers arriving prior to the report date will need to contact the staff duty at 402.309.7170 for instructions.

4.) Can my family attend graduation? Is there lodging available for them?

A.) Yes. Families are encouraged to attend graduation. There are several hotels within minutes of Camp Ashland and cabins are available on Camp Ashland on a first come first serve basis.

5.) Can I receive E-mail/Access the Internet while I am at Camp Ashland?

A.) Yes. Several WiFi Hotspots are available as well as controlled internet access within the classrooms.

6.) Is there a Clothing and Sales store located on Camp Ashland?

A.) No. There is a small PX facility. However, clothing sales and alterations are not available. Students must ensure they bring all required OCIE and that they are IAW AR 670-1.

7.) Am I required to bring a Lensatic compass and protractor (GTA 5-2-12) to WLC?

A.) Yes. The Regiment only has a limited amount available for issue.

8.) Am I required to bring all the TA-50 items listed on my course packing list? A.)

Yes. The Regiment will NOT issue TA-50 items to students attending courses at Camp Ashland. However, during summer months (June-Aug), students are not required to bring extreme cold weather items.

9.) What is the report location? What is the report uniform?

A.) You will report to building 501. The uniform is IPFU. You must have shorts on underneath if in the cold weather IPFU. Spandex is not authorized for HT/WT.
