

1. Log onto Nebraska National Guard webpage, <http://ne.ng.mil/Pages/Default.aspx>.
2. Scroll to the bottom of the webpage, look for the “Other Departments/Link” box and select the “here” hyper link.




Human Resources Center	Includes links to other states, job announcements, Technician info.

5. You will be required to select a DoD CAC certificate.
6. Select your DoD **Email cert** to access your OWA account.




7. Select "OK".
8. You will be prompted to setup your Language and Time Zone before accessing your OWA account, select the following.
9. Language: "English", Time Zone: "0600 (US Central & Canada)".
10. Save to your Favorites
11. Select the URL <https://web-stlm.mail.mil> to access your OWA account




12. You now have successfully logged onto your OWA account.


13. To setup your OWA account for encryption, select "(Options, See All Options)" on the top right hand corner.




14. OWA will let you encrypt and digitally sign e-mail messages you send, view Encrypted content in messages you receive, and verify senders' digital signatures.
15. Select "Settings".
16. "S/MIME" Icon.
17. Select the "Install or reinstall the S/MIME Control" link.
18. Select "Run".



19. Now you've successfully installed S/MIME Control, select "BOTH bullets".
20. Select "Mail" on Top Left Corner.




21. To make sure you have successfully installed S/MIME Control.
22. Select "(New, Message)".
23. The Digital Signature and Encryption Icon should be displayed.



24. You've successfully migrated to Enterprise E-mail Outlook Web Access (EE OWA).
