Military Grade Range: Minimum E3/PFC - Maximum E5/ SGT

Military Requirements: The CPMOS for this position 91E2O. A physical demands rating of heavy. A physical profile of 222222. Qualifying scores. A minimum score of 100 in aptitude area GM in Armed Services Vocational aptitude Battery (ASVAB) tests administered prior to 2 January 2002. A minimum score of (88 in aptitude area GM and 95 in aptitude area GT) or minimum score of 97 in aptitude area GM on ASVAB tests administered on and after 2 January 2002 and prior to 1 July 2004. A minimum score of (88 in aptitude area GM and 95 in aptitude area GT) or a minimum score of 98 in aptitude area GM on ASVAB tests administered on and after 1 July 2004. Near and distance visual acuity correctable to a minimum of 20/30 in each eye is required. Non-MOSQ personnel have one year from date of appointment to become qualified.

Area of Consideration: All eligible members of the Nebraska Army National Guard and individuals who are eligible for Enlistment or transfer into the Nebraska Army National Guard who meet the grade requirements stated in Military Grade Range listed above. In order to be promoted in this position, the Soldier must be on the current EPS list and fully qualified for promotion IAW AR 600-8-19. Soldiers not holding the requisite NCOES for their current grade must agree to complete all NCOES/SSD Requirements within one year of assignment.

General Requirements:

1. Currently assigned E3/PFC- E5/SGT.
2. Not currently "Flagged from Favorable Personnel Actions" or under a "Bar to Reenlistment"
3. Meet other requirements as stated in **Military Requirements** above.

Summary of Duties: Fabricate, repair and modify metallic and nonmetallic parts, utilizing such machines as engine lathes, utility grinders, power cutoff saws, armature undercutters, arbor and hydraulic presses, drill presses, oxyacetylene, electric arc, inert gas welding machines and their associated attachments, accessories and tools. Supervises junior grade Soldiers and provides technical guidance to the Soldiers in the accomplishment of their duties.
