Military Requirements: The CPMOS for this position is 29E4O. A physical demands rating of medium. A physical profile of 222221. Normal Color vision. A minimum score of 100 in aptitude area SC, ST and EL in Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) test. A U.S. citizen. Must have completed a high school algebra course or equivalent. Must complete WLC prior to attending the 29E course. Must meet a security eligibility of Secret and be eligible to receive a TOP SECRET (TS) and Sensitive Compartmented Information (SCI). For a listing of all qualifications for the award of this MOS, they can be found in DA PAM 611-21. Non-MOSQ personnel have one year from date of appointment to become qualified.

Area of Consideration: All eligible members of the Nebraska Army National Guard and individuals who are eligible for Enlistment or transfer into the Nebraska Army National Guard who meet the grade requirements stated in Military Grade Range listed above. In order to be promoted in this position, the Soldier must be on the current EPS list and fully qualified for promotion IAW AR 600-8-19. Soldiers not holding the requisite NCOES for their current grade must agree to complete all NCOES/SSD Requirements within one year of assignment.

General Requirements:

1. Currently assigned E5/SGT- E7/SFC.
2. Not currently "Flagged from Favorable Personnel Actions" or under a "Bar to Reenlistment"
3. Meet other requirements as stated in **Military Requirements** above.

Summary of Duties: Primary enlisted EW advisor or member of the EW element at the Brigade or higher echelons; ensures support to subordinate units; works equipment and resource issues with and between higher, adjacent and subordinate units; prioritizes allocation of Army EW air and ground assets; reviews and processes AEA requests; coordinates AEA mission execution. Assists with integration of cyberspace electromagnetic operations.

Application Instructions: Apply by submitting a completed packet in accordance with Traditional NCO Vacancy Application

Applications may be submitted by e-mail or digital sharing to the GI no later than 1600 hours on the closing date.
