Grade Requirement: Minimum MSgt eligible for SMSgt– Maximum SMSgt **AFSC:** Any AFSC

Minimum Qualifications:

- Must have or be able to attain 48 months of retainability.
- Must have demonstrated strong leadership, managerial skills, and strong public speaking skills.
- If not completed, must enroll and complete the USAF Senior NCO Academy Course within 12 months of selection of this position.

Specialty Qualifications:

- Knowledge of Air Force readiness and compliance objectives, enlisted leadership and management concepts and their relationship to mission accomplishment is mandatory.
- Knowledge of the Air Force Inspection System (AFIS), the Commander's Inspection Program (CCIP), and information systems used by the IG office.
- Must possess a CCAF degree, or civilian equivalent, in primary AFSC and be current in all professional military education commensurate with current grade.
- Present or future completion of the Air Force Inspector General Training Course-Inspections is mandatory IAW AFI 90-201 timeline. The course is approximately one week in duration.
- Must be the minimum grade of E-7. Previous IG experience at the unit, wing or MAJCOM desired.
- Other:
 - Demonstrated ability to prepare written reports.
 - No Unfavorable Information File or open IG investigations.
 - Must possess current Secret (minimum) security clearance IAW DoDM 5200.02, AFMAN 16-1405, Air Force Personnel Security Program.
 - For entry and retention of this specialty, must meet requirements listed in AFI 90-201, The Air Force Inspection Program and AFI 90- 301, Inspector General Complaints Resolution.

Duties and Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Senior Enlisted Leader/Advisor to the Inspector General. Plans, conducts, and monitors IG activities.
- Assists IG on overall operation, administration, and management of inspections, Complaints Resolution, FWA Program, and CCIP.
- Manages and develops the enlisted personnel within the Wing IG office.
- Organizes IG activities. Develops, establishes, and controls methods and procedures to implement IG policies and programs. Provides oversight and policy guidance concerning IG program, plans, requirements, management, education and awareness initiatives.

- Manages and conducts the 155 ARW By-Law Inspection Program
- Provides IG inspection support. Maintains liaison with the Wing IG, wing inspection team members, MAJCOM/IG and SAF/IG as appropriate to receive, process, refer, and manage inspection information, resources, assets, and activities to support operation and management of the Air Force's Inspection and Complaints Resolution and FWA Programs. Serves as liaison within the functional community.
