TRADITIONAL VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT

Position Title & Unit: Combat Engineer, A Co, **Location:** Yutan, NE
2-134th Infantry Battalion (ABN) (**Two
Positions**)

Military Grade Range: Minimum SPC/E-4 – Maximum SGT/E-5

Military Requirements: Designated CPMOS for this position 12B. Soldier must hold or be eligible to obtain a SECRET security clearance. Applicant must already be MOS qualified to apply. Individuals selected will remain assigned to current unit and attached for mobilization. Soldier will return to current unit of assignment upon completion of Yellow Ribbon requirements (approximately 90 days after REFRAD).

Area of Consideration: All eligible and available members of the Nebraska Army National Guard serving in the grade range listed above.

General Requirements:

1. Currently assigned 12B SPC/E-4 – SGT/E-5 of the Nebraska Army National Guard
2. Not currently "Flagged from Favorable Personnel Actions", under a "Bar to Reenlistment", or defined as "Stagnant".
3. Meet other requirements as stated in **Military Requirements** above.
4. Ability to travel in accordance with current DOD guidance and travel regulations.

Summary of Duties: Provide operational support to an Infantry Company assigned to the AFRICOM AOR. Soldiers will be required to function in an austere environment supporting defensive and mobility operations. SM should have a thorough understanding of mobility, counter-mobility, and survivability in support of combat forces.

Electronic applications must be in PDF format on one single attachment. The use of official mail to forward employment applications is prohibited.
