Grade Requirement: Minimum SMSgt eligible for CMSgt; Current CMSgts

AFSC Requirement: Any AFSC

Minimum Qualifications:

- Must have or be able to attain 48 months of retainability.
- Must have demonstrated strong leadership, managerial skills, and strong public speaking skills.
- Must have a 7 level or 9-level in any AFSC.
- Must have completed the USAF Senior NCO Academy Course.

Area of Consideration: This announcement is open nationwide. All current enlisted members of the Nebraska Air National Guard and those eligible to become members.

Specialty Qualifications:

- Must complete Chief Master Sergeant Orientation Course (CMSOC) within one year of promotion to CMSgt (if currently a SMSgt)
- Must possess a CCAF degree, or civilian equivalent and be current in all professional military education commensurate with current grade.
- Must possess current Secret (minimum) security clearance IAW DoDM 5200.02, AFMAN 16-1405, Air Force Personnel Security Program.

Duties and Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- In addition to the Group SEL responsibilities outlined in The Enlisted Force Structure Book “Brown Book” dated 16 MAY 2022, the MXG SEL is responsible to the MXG/CC and shall advise and assist the MXG/CC on their responsibilities as outlined in DAFI 21-101, Chapter 2.
- Provide the enlisted force with mentoring, training, and leadership across the aircraft maintenance complex
- Provide leadership and management with regards to organizing, training, equipping, and mobilizing the unit or group to meet mission requirements.
- Ensure promotion, retention, force management and enlisted recognition programs are supported and advocated through the enlisted and officer force.
