Brigadier General (BG) Kevin Lyons serves as the Assistant Adjutant General - Army for the Nebraska Army National Guard. He also serves as the Land Component Commander responsible for approximately 3400 Nebraska soldiers.

BG Kevin Lyons began his military service in the Nebraska Army National Guard in 1986 as a tank crewman in Kearney, Nebraska. He graduated from the Nebraska National Guard Officer Candidate School in 1990 and was commissioned a Second Lieutenant on June 30, 1990.

BG Lyons' military schooling includes Armor Officer Basic and Advance Courses, Combined Arms Service School, Command and General Staff College, and the Army War College. He has held command and staff positions at the company, battalion, brigade and state levels. His awards and decorations include the Legion of Merit, Bronze Star Medal, Meritorious Service Medal, and numerous other Federal and State awards.

He holds a Bachelor of Science in Education degree from Kearney State College, a Masters of Arts degree in 7-12 Principal and an Education Specialist degree in K-12 Superintendent both from the University of Nebraska at Kearney, and a Masters of Strategic Studies degree from the United States Army War College.
