### CHIEF MASTER SERGEANT TYRONE F. BINGHAM

Chief Master Sergeant Tyrone Bingham is the seventh Command Chief for the state of Nebraska. He advises the Adjutant General, Assistant Adjutant General (Air) and other key personnel on matters influencing the health, morale and welfare of Nebraska Air National Guard Enlisted Airmen and their families.

CMSgt Bingham enlisted into the United States Air Force on February 21, 1995 at the Nashville, Tennessee, Military Enlistment Process Station. He arrived at Lackland Air Force Base, Texas for Basic Military Training May 18, 1995. September of 1995, he started his Air Force Specialty Course as an Operations Resource Management Craftsman at Keesler Air Force Base, Mississippi. His first assignment was with the 1st Fighter Wing, 27th Fighter Squadron, Langley Air Force Base, Virginia, as an Operations Resource Management Journeyman. He was then assigned to the 375th Air Medical Wing, Scott Air Force Base, Illinois, September of 1996 as an Operations Resource Manager in aircraft scheduling. In 1999 Chief Bingham joined the 131st Fighter Wing, Missouri Air National Guard, St Louis, Missouri as a Production Recruiter. In 2002 he joined a Geographic Separated Unit to the 131st Fighter Wing, Jefferson Barracks, as the NCOIC of Aviation Resource Management. In 2005 Chief Bingham joined the 170th Operations Squadron, Nebraska Air National Guard, Nebraska, as the 55th Wing Superintendent of the Host Aviation Resource Management Office. In 2010 he became a part of the Air National Guard Readiness Center, Training and Education Center, Knoxville, Tennessee. He served as the Director of Education for the Noncommissioned Officer and Airman Leadership Schools, Enlisted Professional Military Education Courses. In 2013 he became the Host Aviation Resource Management Superintendent in Standards and Evaluations for 1st Air Force, Air Forces Northern, Tyndall Air Force Base, Florida. In 2015 he served as superintendent for 170th Group, Nebraska Air National Guard, Offutt Air Force Base, Nebraska. CMSgt Bingham was responsible for the morale, health and welfare of 80 Airman and Officers.



In 2009 he supported both Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation Enduring Freedom at Bagram Air Field, Afghanistan and Al Udeid Air Base, Qatar, Doha as the Host Aviation Resource Management Superintendent. In 2010 he was named SNCO of the year for the Air National Guard. He also received the Director's award for leadership in 2010. Finally, in 2010 he was awarded the 12 Outstanding Airman of the Year ribbon for performance and leadership.
